South Bay Energy Rewards Program was a Success!

The Torrance South Bay Energy Rewards (SBER) Program was highly successful in 2003. The City worked with building owners and Energy Innovation Group (EIG), which assisted in securing funds through the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC). Through the SBER program many building owners and managers qualified for State funding to help reduce energy costs in their buildings. The program paid over \$165,000 in rebate money for 51 Torrance buildings with approximately \$200,000 in projected annual savings.

Although the SBER program is over, there are still ways for business owners to reduce energy costs and receive special rebates:

- Special rebates cover up to 50% of the cost of small businesses to reduce lighting costs.
- New lighting equipment can cut lighting costs 40% or more.
- New air conditioning equipment can cut energy costs often up to 50%.
- For commercial enclosed garages, controls greatly reduce exhaust fan running time.
- For commercial buildings, controls eliminate the costs for over-ventilation of outside air.
